NOTICE OF REFERENDUM**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at the election to be held on Tuesday, February 2, 2010, the following propositions will be submitted to the voters of DeKalb Park District, Waterman Community Fire Protection District and Fairdale Street Light District.

**DEKALB PARK DISTRICT
PROPOSITION TO ISSUE BONDS
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,000,000**

Shall the DeKalb Park District, DeKalb County, Illinois, build and equip an Aquatics Center at Hopkins Park to replace the existing Aquatic Center, provide other site improvements to Hopkins Park and issue its bonds to the amount of \$15,000,000 for the purpose of paying the costs thereof?

**WATERMAN COMMUNITY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT
PROPOSITION TO INCREASE LIMITING RATE**

Shall the limiting rate under the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law for the Waterman Community Fire Protection District, DeKalb County, Illinois, be increased by an additional amount equal to .21307% above the limiting rate for the purpose of improving fire protection and ambulance services for levy year 2008 and be equal to .40% of the equalized assessed value of the taxable property for levy years 2009, 2010, 2011, and 2012?

1. The approximate amount of taxes extendable at the most recently extended limiting rate is \$117,872.58, and the approximate amount of taxes extendable if the proposition is approved is \$252,228.28.

2. For the 2009 levy year the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against property containing a single family residence and having a fair market value at the time of the referendum of \$100,000 is estimated to be \$71.02.

3. Based upon an average annual percentage increase in the market value of such property of 6.586% the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against such property for the 2010 levy year is estimated to be \$79.80, and for the 2011 levy year is estimated to be \$89.16, and for the 2012 levy year is estimated to be \$99.14.

4. If the proposition is approved, the aggregate extension for 2009, 2010, 2011, and 2012 will be determined by the limiting rate set forth in the proposition, rather than the otherwise applicable limiting rate calculated under the provisions of the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law (commonly known as the Property Tax Cap Law).

**FAIRDALE STREETS & LIGHTS DISTRICT
PROPOSITION TO INCREASE EXTENSION LIMITATION**

Shall the limiting rate under the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law for the Fairdale Streets & Lights District, Fairdale, Illinois, be increased by an additional amount equal to 182.36% above the limiting rate for the purpose of providing lighting for levy year 2008, and be equal to .19999% of the equalized assessed value of the taxable property therein for levy year(s) 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013?

The ballot for this question shall have printed thereon, but not as a part of the questions submitted, only the following supplemental information in substantially the following form:

1) The approximate amount of taxes extendable at the most recently extended limiting rate is \$2316, and the approximate amount of taxes extendable if the proposition is approved is \$4042.

2) For the 2010 levy year the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against property containing a single family residence and having a fair market value at the time of the referendum of \$100,000 is estimated to be \$30.10.

3) Based upon an average annual percentage increase (or decrease) in the market value of such property of 3.23%, the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against such property for the 2010 levy year is estimated to be \$30.10 and for the 2011 levy year is estimated to be \$30.98.

4) If the proposition is approved, the aggregate extension for 2010 will be determined by the limiting rate set forth in the proposition, rather than the otherwise applicable limiting rate calculated under the provisions of the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law.

The polls of said General Primary shall be open continuously from 6:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 2, 2010.
