<i>Glass Containers</i>	<i>Aluminum & Tin Cans</i>	<i>Plastic Containers</i>
Only bottles and jars are acceptable. Clear, brown, and green are acceptable. All bottles and jars should be clean, empty with <i>lids discarded</i> . (into the trash)	Cans should be empty, without any food in them. Foil products are acceptable. Cans may be flattened to conserve container space.	Jugs and bottles with the numbers 1, 2 & 5 Please empty all bottles and discard the caps. <i>All items must be EMPTY!</i> <u>NO</u> other plastics regardless of markings. <u>NO</u> Plastic bags. <u>NO</u> Automotive or pesticide containers.
